

# EQUIPMENT CLEANING GUIDELINES FOR COVID-19 PROTECTION

## Plastics



Wash & rinse, then spray and dry.

## Card Sets



Use online simulations if possible. Laminate cards or put non-laminated cards in sealed bag. Wipe after each use.

## Metal



Avoid bleach, corrosive, or oxidizing agent. Wash & rinse, then spray/wipe with >70% alcohol disinfectant.

## Cloth



Laundry or let sit unused for 3 days.

Spray with disinfectant and dry immediately to avoid water absorption and possible damage.



## Wood

Use online portals if possible; wipe down covers; rotate book so each sits unused for 3+ days.



## Books

Wash & rinse, then spray.



## Glass

Use >70% alcohol wipes or spray on paper towel, then dry surface thoroughly.



## Electronics

## General Procedure

1. Wash hands, wear a mask, use gloves.
2. First wash & rinse with soap and water when applicable.
3. Disinfect as the last step - wipe in one direction, not circles.
4. Consider adding a wipeable cover to shared keyboards and touchscreens.

**Recommended General Disinfectants** Thymol (component of thyme oil) based disinfectant • Freshly prepared 10% bleach solution. • 70% ethanol (particularly for electronics and other delicate surfaces). • Any disinfectant EPA certified as effective against SARS-CoV-2.
